I want to try out caving, what do I have to do?

- Contact the club via the details below and book in for a beginners caving trip
- Pay a low cost introductory membership of \$30 for singles or \$45 for a family, (for the first year) that covers public liability insurance for going caving (a requirement for accessing many cave areas).
- Borrow a set of club caving safety gear required for the trip
- Car pool or self-drive to the caving location
- Wear long clothing that you do not mind getting dirty and bring a clean set for the way home
- Gloves to keep your hands clean and perhaps some padding for your knees to make it more fun
- Come on your own or with a friend and you will make more friends on the day

Am I too old, young, unfit, tall, short or afraid to try caving?

No!

The Club has a wide range of members who all enjoy and get the most out of each caving trip.

With decades of combined caving experience you will be in safe hands and each trip is run to meet the needs and experience of the group on the day.

Young people are catered for as part of Family introductory memberships and several trips each year are designed for such members.

If you feel uncomfortable there will be a member who can take you back to the start but normally the camaraderie on the day helps even the most nervous person achieve a great caving experience.

Where can I go caving and canyoning with the Club?

CSS visits many caving sites around the Canberra region and sometimes joins other groups for trips further afield.

Some locations include:

- Cooleman Plain and Yarrangobilly , in the Kosciusko National Park
- Bungonia National Park, near Goulburn
- Wombeyan Caves, north of Goulburn
- Macquarie Pass Canyon, near Robertson
- Wee Jasper

Many of the caves we go to require permits, so we are able to visit places that are not accessible to the general public.
